Founded in 1989 and located in Los Angeles, California, APADRC seeks to create peace in its community and beyond by improving race and human relations in Los Angeles and virtually on a national level.

## What makes them unique?

APADRC specialized in providing culturally sensitive dispute resolution. With most of the staff bilingual, APADRC provides resolution in individuals' native languages, reaching people on a more fundamental level.

## Their Programs

"Building Pathways to Understanding" is a community dialogue series aimed to provide a safe, shared informal learning space for people from different communities to have conversations about a variety of issues in a way that may not be possible in ordinary life. APADRC's Restorative Justice program provides emotional support to all sides of the #BlackLivesMatter protests in Los Angeles and related areas. APADRC also offers a COVID-19 community workgroup, free English workshops, and Latinx and Chinese community support.
