Footprints on the Heart provides peer support to families who face the unimaginable loss of a baby in the first two years of life. This support includes being present with families at the time of loss to make lasting memories, help with funeral planning, providing peer support, and various community outreach opportunities and events.

How Can You Help?

Locals can volunteer to support families or administrative functions of the organization. Anyone can make a donation to support the organization's campaign to secure a physical location to better serve bereaved families or any of the nonprofit's programs.

What makes them unique?

Footprints on the Heart is the only organization in its community of Kingston and Bartow County, Georgia that provides free in-person support and services for families during and after the loss of a baby or toddler, meeting a need in its community that would otherwise go under served.

Their Programs

Footprints on the Heart offers photography services to local families. Its H.O.P.E. boxes (offering hope, ongoing support, prayer, and encouragement) are provided to three local hospitals, a funeral home, and in-person, the contents of which are customized based on the needs of each family. Each family served receives a keepsake memorial necklace.
